The Imhotep Academy PTA " Charter Night" Meeting

Ms. Perrino presented the elected President, Ms. Anne Davis, with a basic registration to the Annual PTA Leadership Conference at the Georgia International Convention Center that will take place this summer.

Ms. Davis introduced herself and gave her vision for the inaugural year of the IPTA.
